ANDY JOE (Yorktown, IN) is a piano student of Liz Seidel and a violin student of Sherry Kloss. He has studied piano for 13 years and violin for 12 years. His honors in piano include first place in both the Junior and Senior level National Federation of Music Clubs State Competition and 1st place in the NFMC Winners Circle Competition. As a violinist, he is the concertmaster in the East Central Indiana Youth Orchestra. He is also founding member of The trazoM Trio. This will be Andy's fifth year attending the Music Symposium. Next year Andy will be attending Cornell University and majoring in physics.

ALEX UEMATSU (Tenafly, NJ) started playing violin at the age of three, then picked up the trumpet at eight as well as the baritone and other brass instruments, and as recent as to years ago he started guitar. Alex will be a sophomore in high school next year.
